Violin

****Alternative repertoire will be approved on a case by case basis.****

Undergraduate Degrees

Bachelor of Music Performance

- One movement from a J.S. Bach solo sonata or partita
- One movement of a standard concerto
- One additional contrasting piece. An etude is also accepted in this category.

(It is highly recommended that at least one selection be performed from memory)

Bachelor of Music Education

- One movement from a J.S. Bach solo sonata or partita
- One movement of a standard concerto or sonata

(It is highly recommended that at least one selection be performed from memory)

Bachelor of Music in Music Therapy

- Two contrasting movements from the standard violin literature

Graduate Degrees

Master of Music

- Two contrasting movements from any J.S. Bach solo sonata or partita
- One movement of a standard concerto
- One movement of a standard sonata

Unaccompanied movements by Bach must be performed from memory. It is highly recommended that the concerto also be memorized.

Doctor of Musical Arts

- Two contrasting movements from any J.S. Bach solo sonata or partita
- One movement of a standard concerto
- One movement of a standard sonata

- A 20th century work of the applicants choice

Unaccompanied movements by Bach and the concerto must be performed from memory.

******All applicants must audition in person to be considered for admission and scholarship. DVDs from applicants living outside the continental U.S. will be considered on a case by case basis.******
